- You will head back towards the Boat House Restaurant, park in their lot and you will see our dock.

### Tips from a sailor:

The **Log book** is from ASA and is where you can keep your certification seals, log your sailing hours, as well as find out what each certification covers. This is a must have especially if you plan on getting higher certifications.

**Rules of the Road** are good to have so you have a quick reference guide for right of way rules. The **Rules of Racing** is an excellent reference if you believe that you want to learn how to race.

**Charts** are always good to have around, and the **Navigation set** we offer has all the basic tools you will need for your kit and costs less than buying the tools all separately.

**Sailing Gloves** are an essential item; you can grip the lines and not have to worry about rope burn. Available in sizes S-XL

**Floppy hats** are great to have because they protect both your eyes and the back of your neck from the sun.

A **Rigging Knife** or other multi purpose tool is not only useful but a good idea for safety purposes.

**Sailing Bags** are good items to have because they are waterproof and are easier to clean than typical duffel bags.
